4. Renewable Energy – Reported by Travis

- In reviewing our energy bills and have come upon some questions that I need answered by Redwood Coast Energy Authority (RCEA). I have questions about peak time usage but haven't heard back from
- The Co-op is in the Medium Use Industrial tier which is the best tier for us.
- Switching over to 100% renewable energy would be about \$1,400 extra per month.
- 100% renewable from RCEA is cheaper than the same from PG&E. We currently save \$70-\$400 monthly by using RCEA over PG&E.
- The solar panels in Arcata don't seem to be hooked up and doesn't show up on our energy bill.
- Best estimate with new solar panels in Arcata is that we could generate 40-45% of Arcata's energy. I'm looking into the costs of new solar panels and any rebates that could be used.
- The biggest cost of power is for refrigeration and air movement.
- Our usage compared to last year is about even, but we should see a decrease following the remodel.

5. Transportation Survey – Reported by Laurie

The group reviewed a draft transportation survey. The survey would be focused on Arcata first. Due to limited staff time, we are not sure when the survey will be implemented. Overall the group liked the survey and didn't see any needed changes to the questions. There was discussion about conducting the survey at different times of the year/weather conditions. When the surveys are conducted we will make sure to note the weather and any other abnormalities that day.
